

# Republican Activist Plan 2018

So, you want to make sure Republicans win in November, but don't know where to start? We have 9 ways you can help:

## 1. Volunteer for a candidate

It is easy to get people interested in a Presidential election. However, off year elections include county, district, and state races that have a bigger impact on daily life. The candidates for these positions have a much more difficult time in raising money and getting volunteers. Pick your favorite candidate and volunteer. The impact you make will be huge!

## 2. Sign Wave

Sign waving is an important tool, especially to **motivate, encourage, and inspire** others to take action. Go out to a busy street corner, sign wave, & **always** have someone take a picture. Post your results on social media.

Examples:

Democrats choose illegal aliens over American citizens. VOTE REPUBLICAN  
Trump's and Alabama's Tax Cuts Gave Me More Money. VOTE REPUBLICAN  
Support our Republican Candidates. VOTE REPUBLICAN = TAX CUTS

Make sure your signs are easy to read by passing cars!

## 3. Bumper Stickers

Get your favorite candidate's bumper sticker. Get more than one! Every bumper sticker is worth \$250 in free advertising. Make sure to park your vehicle strategically for maximum visibility.

## 6. Register to Vote

## 7. Become a Poll Watcher

## 8. 3 by 3

3 by 3 means reaching out to three of your neighbors three times. This is a great way to build relationships, show that you care about your community, and get out the vote this June and November:

- Knock on your neighbors' doors who live (1) across the street, as well as (2) to your left (3) and right
- If your neighborhood is not set up this way, then just choose 3 neighbors
- First contact: "Hi, my name is \_\_\_\_\_ and I'm your neighbor. I just wanted to introduce myself and make sure you're registered to vote at this address. It's so important that we get out and vote for jobs, a strong economy, and putting the American people first."
- Second contact: Write each of the 3 neighbors a handwritten thank you card after your first visit. "Hey, \_\_\_\_\_. This is \_\_\_\_\_. I just wanted to say it was a pleasure talking to you the other day. If you ever need anything, please don't hesitate to stop by."
- Third contact: Before Election Day, on Tuesday, June 5th (or Tuesday, November 6<sup>th</sup>), 2018, visit these 3 neighbors one last time and remind them about the Republican candidates running for office.

## **9. Post on social media**

Post to Twitter and Facebook about our Republican candidates. Remind your friends why it is important to vote in June and November. Post photos of your favorite candidate or about the Republican party/conservative ideals tied to the election. Invite your followers/friends to vote on June 5th (or November 6th).
